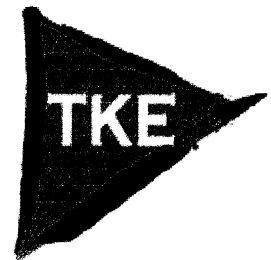

Several projects have been identified along with some general maintenance projects to be completed.

Please plan to join us on **Saturday, April 22 at 8:30 a.m. at the TKE House** for a fun and productive day helping your fraternity. A light breakfast & lunch will be provided.

As you may know, the projects for the house can't go without your support. We are looking for two kinds of support. We need your help with labor to complete the projects, but we also need your help with resources for the day, both financial and use of tools or other resources that you might have access to.

2006 Planned TKE House Work Day Projects

- Paint: TKE Bell, TKE letters in entry way, North & South Stairwells, bathrooms, touch up chapter room, chapter room ceiling
- Move TKE Yard Sign and plant similar maple tree from the 222 W. Cooper TKE House
- Complete movable TV cart and move cable outlet, install TV in the pool room
- Purchase & install new 2" blinds in chapter room
- Install bike racks, permanent grill & basketball hoop if possible
- Minor concrete work
- Touch up and drywall & general repair work
- Install TKE House Communication center, mailbox area and new bulletin boards
- Spring fertilizer and yard treatments, re-mulch flower beds, trim bushes



Supplies needed include the following:

- Paint supplies: paint, paint sprayer, paint brushes, drop cloths, scaffolding, ladders
- Yard Project supplies: pre-emergent, fertilizer, spreaders, shovels, rakes, mulch
- Financial support for: blinds in chapter room, bike rack, grill, basketball hoop
- Money for: meals for the work crew & general cleaning supplies and maintenance items

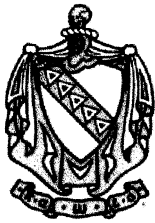
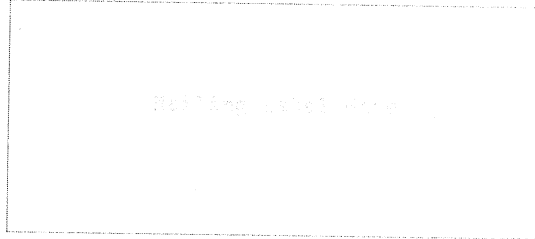
