We would like to thank you for the

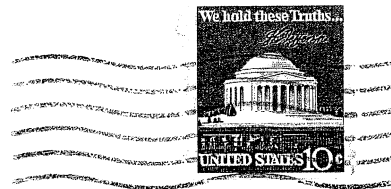
alumni dues that we have received since the last Delta Nu Review. All dues received are greatly appreciated and will be put to good use in the improvement of our chapter.
