The Board of Trustees has been busy with the activities of selling the property at 222 West Cooper and purchasing property adjacent to the University on 9th Street near the Northwest corner of the University Campus. The property has been title searched and an environmental survey was conducted to ensure that no problems will be encountered down the road with additional financing or construction.

Plans for a new house are being developed. The “dream” plan for an ideal house will probably be too expensive, but the Board of Trustees is committed to work toward the most optimum design that will incorporate all the needs of Delta Nu and still be affordable. A formal Fund Raising Committee has been formed and I would like to thank the alumni that have said “yes” to the invitation to serve on this committee. A meeting of the committee will be held on May 17th. Designing the fund raising campaign and developing the network that will be necessary to contact each alumni of Delta Nu will be a big task. This effort is hopefully nearing fruition and the formal fund raising campaign should be underway in a few weeks.

The effort to locate those Fraters that we do not have good addresses on is progressing. The input of alumni as a result of the “listing” in the last issue of Delta Nu has been great. We have new addresses on nearly 75 Fraters whose addresses were not accurate in our database for one reason or another. As you may recall, we lost the most updated database in the November fire and had to rebuild on an older database that was saved.
