Following the ground-breaking the assembled were asked to gather at the J W Jones Student Union for a brief awards ceremony. This done the active chapter convened a formal meeting. For most of the alumni this was the first formal meeting since they were members of the active chapter. The Board of Trustees has authorized the architect to proceed with construction drawings for the project. A water control project has delayed progress to some extent. This project will involve close liaison with the University and the City of Maryville. Fraters Rod Auxier and Larry Apple have been working closely with this issue. A recent meeting came up with several options and an imminent meeting of the Board of Trustees should complete final plans for this phase of the project and allow the Board to proceed with bid letting and the commencement of construction very soon. Due to water considerations and site elevations, a basement is not possible but alternative plans to include similar spaces have been developed and are under review.

The Alumni Fund Raising Committee continues to work hard toward the goal of 200,000. A Phone-a-Thon was held at the University Alumni House on Saturday, February 21, 1998. This was a very successful project. The total in contributions and pledges has grown to about the \$100,000 level and continues to gain momentum. I was personally a bit disappointed by the Alumni participation in this Phone-a-Thon event. The Fund Raising Committee continues to be the major contributor to the fund raising effort. I solicit each Delta Nu Alumni to grab the phone and contact a person that does not show up on the contributor list and ask them to support the project. This is **YOUR HOUSE** and will take the effort of all of us if the project completes the way the Board and Fund Raising Committee have planned.

If you or your company (and we solicit all the help we can get) are interested in contributing "**In Kind**" in some creative and innovative way, the Board needs to know this very soon. Roofing, siding, floor coverings, paint, labor, fixtures, furniture, construction management, landscaping, trees/shrubs, and the list goes on and on, of the ways you might be able to help the **FRATERNITY** project. 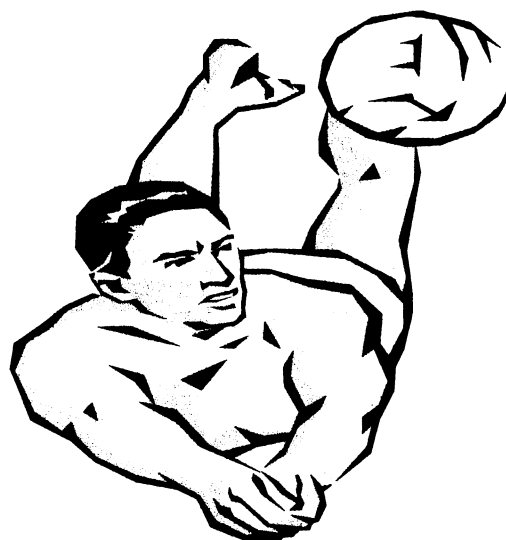
