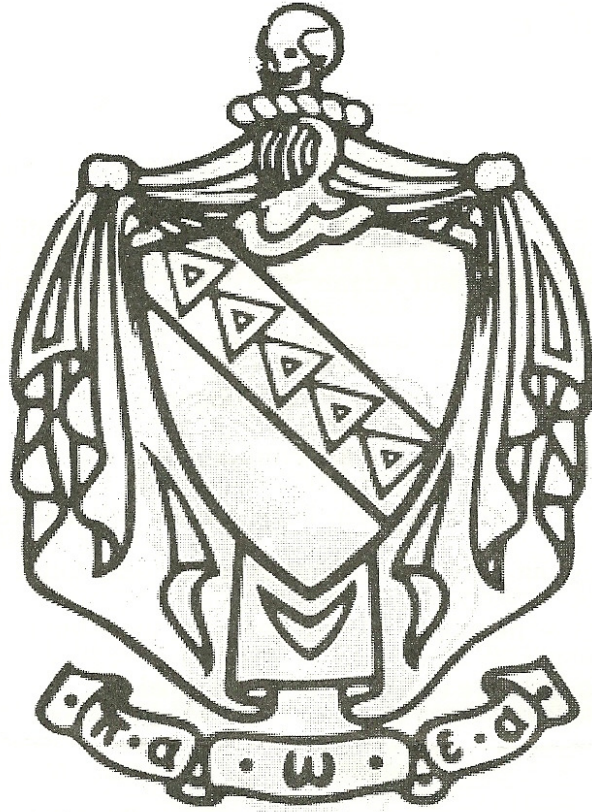

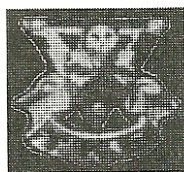
## Welcome

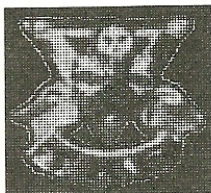


## Prytanis Report

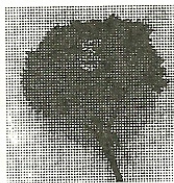


## *Epiprytanis-Homecoming*

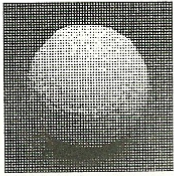

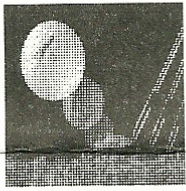

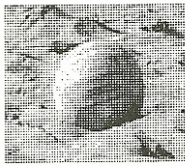
