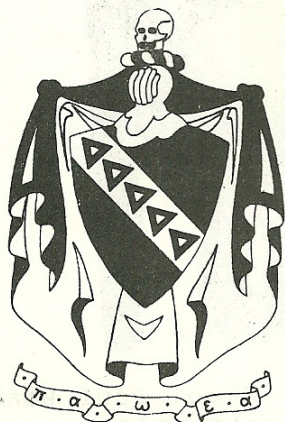

We are very proud to have Ron represent the TKES and the other organizations on campus. Congratulations Frater Ron!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

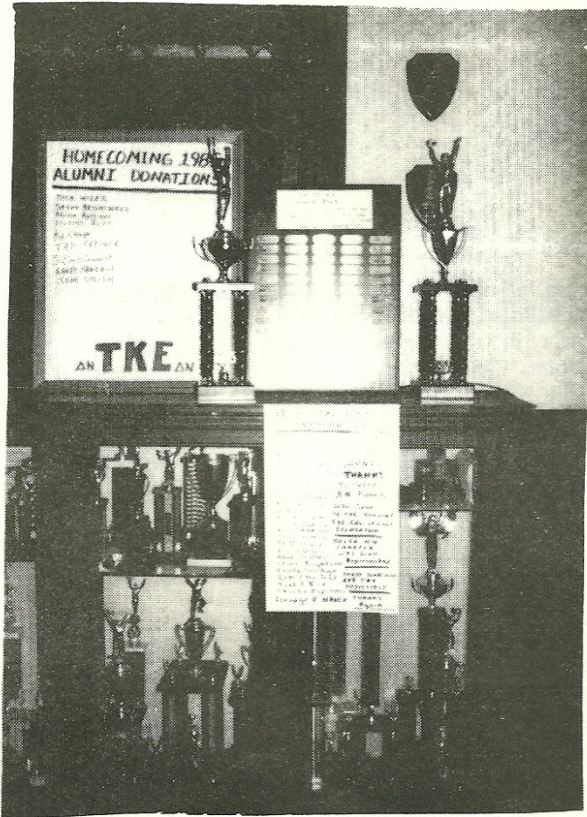
