### What activities will my annual membership fees support?

# How is the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association governed and how do I get involved?

The Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association is governed as part of the Delta Nu TKE Board of Advisors. The Alumni Association chairman sits on the Board of Advisors and is responsible for coordinating the alumni association plans, the alumni events calendar and the event organizers, such as for the golf or bowling tournaments.

The easiest way to get involved in and support the Alumni Association is to send in your dues every year. Your dues will go to fund the activities of the alumni association, alumni events as well as special projects approved by the Board of Advisors. Other ways Fraters can get involved in the Alumni Association is to volunteer to help organize and run events, participate in fundraisers, participate in work weekend, mentor actives and chapter officers, assist at rush and pledge events, etc.

## Is the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association a social organization?

Organized in 2005, the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association maintains active involvement with the local chapter as well as alumni around the U.S. to foster good fellowship and loyalty among Alumni, students and friends, to encourage the educational ideals for which the Delta Nu TKE represents and to promote general interest in Delta Nu TKE. In addition to maintaining addresses of Fraters, the Alumni Association sponsors scholarships and awards, publishes a semi-annual newsletter and sponsors annual Homecoming gatherings, and the annual Bowling and Golf tournaments, in addition to other events during the year.

### What is the goal of the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association?

Our goal is to assist in promoting the welfare of Delta Nu TKE by enlisting alumni to become members of the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association. This goal will be achieved by supporting scholarships, which provide broader educational opportunities to the students and alumni of Northwest Missouri State University and by encouraging gifts from members for such proper means as may seem advisable. Membership dues are used only to offset the costs of operating these efforts.

# What are the scholarship funds the Alumni Association manages?

Through the Northwest Foundation, the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association manages two scholarship funds – the Peter J. Greve Memorial TKE Alumni Scholarship and the TKE Memorial Scholarship. These scholarships are awarded to Northwest students that apply for and meet the established criteria of each scholarship. ## Why should I contribute to the one or more of the Delta Nu Alumni Scholarship Funds?

Each scholarship recipient must sign an agreement to abide by the stipulations of the individual scholarships thus making the recipient accountable to the Scholarship Committee and ultimately the donor.

These scholarships bring positive attention and exposure to the Delta NU TKE chapter as well as recognize worthy undergrads and incoming freshman with the opportunity to offset some of the cost of tuition. Even before the Association was established, the Delta Nu TKE Alumni Association awarded the Delta Nu TKE Scholarship to worthy undergrads. In the last four years, approximately seven different scholarships have been awarded totaling more than \$7,000.
