Homecoming '97 in Review

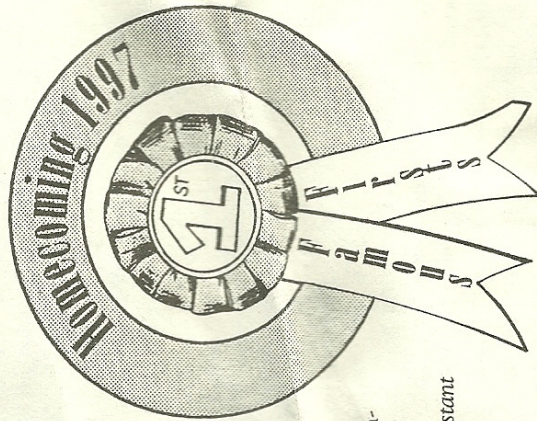

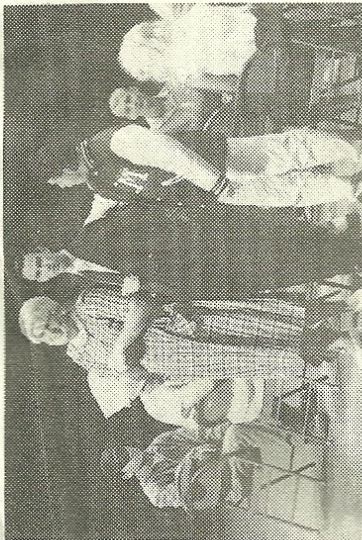

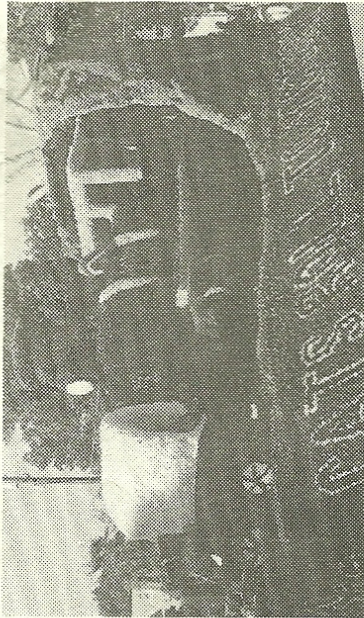
