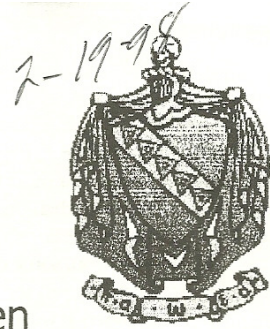

## New House Update: Making it Happen

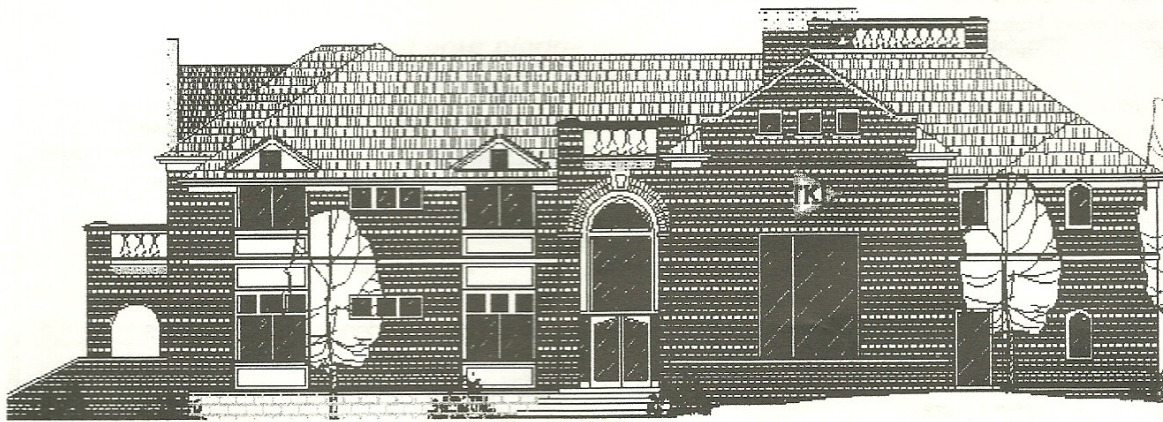
Fellow Alumni Fraters of Delta Nu,

It's been 15 months since a fire destroyed the TKE house we all remember on the corner of Cooper and Filmore streets. Since that time, the old lot on Cooper has been sold, a new lot in a prime location next to the campus has been purchased and a campaign to raise funds for the new TKE house has been implemented.

On November 15, 1997, the formal "Groundbreaking" ceremony was held at TKE's new location with 175 Delta Nu supporters in attendance. Currently over \$70,000 has been raised with only 150 fraters participating in the fund drive to date.

***"And they said it couldn't be done."***

Our success thus far will allow us to take the next step toward our goal of a new facility for Delta Nu. Lot preparation will begin this spring, however we alumni are not finished with the task at hand. The goal for the fund drive is to raise \$200,000 from TKE alumni, undergraduates and friends of Delta Nu chapter. With the current success, that leaves \$130,000 yet to be committed from the remaining alumni and active members. With the trend set by the first 150 supporters, this goal can be met and even surpassed! We have no doubt it can be done. With the resources of the remaining 1100 Delta Nu alumni this should be an achievable and exceedable goal! The time is now to consider our cause and get on board!

But as we all know...the brotherhood that we all remember and still reflect upon has provided the foundation to continue Delta Nu and make it even better.

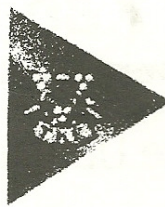
The alumni Board of Trustees, under the leadership of Chairman Larry Apple, Scroll #325, has been very busy assuring the chapters future. Land adjacent to the university on 9<sup>th</sup> street has been purchased by the Delta Nu Housing Corporation for construction of the new TKE house. *(The first project of its type on the Northwest campus.)* In May of 1997, the Board appointed a Fundraising Committee of Fraters from all era's of Delta Nu's history. Our task...to raise funds to construct a new TKE house for Delta Nu.

Our committee has been extremely busy developing, implementing and executing a plan to allow involvement of all alumni Delta Nu Tekes. *Many thanks to all of those alumni fraters who have assisted with all of our plans, projects and gatherings, as well as those who have submitted a pledge to our cause.* Without you, we would not be at this point with this project and be "The Fraternity to watch" on the Northwest campus.

*We hope you'll take a few moments to reflect on your time at Northwest and your time as a Teke. Remembering those unique times while you were in Maryville. The friendships...the stories...competing...winning...pomping the homecoming float, and all those times that you probably still recall as they just happened yesterday!*

## Q & A



Dear Fraters:

There have been several questions raised during the fundraising process for ht new house at Delta Nu that I would like to address.

Q. Why \$500,000 for a new house in Maryville?

A. We are building a house for thirty-two men with approximately 8000 square feet of living space for approximately \$50 per square foot. A typical house for a family would run \$65 to \$75 per square foot.

Q. Why not rebuild at 222 W. Cooper?

A. The maximum number of men would have been under fifteen to meet city codes. TKE national has indicated that thirty men is a minimum to cash flow a house.

Q. Why not buy an existing house in Maryville for \$60,000 to \$100,000?

A. Zoning is not available and you still have an old house.

Q. Are the Alumni building the Actives a new house?

A. No, the house will cost \$500,000. The Alumni are being asked to help with the down payment and possible furnishings to off set the mortgage.

Q. How will the mortgage be paid for during the summer?

A. Cash flow projections are based on a 12-month payment. Students will be able to live in the house cheaper than the dorms and at the same rent or less than quality off campus housing.

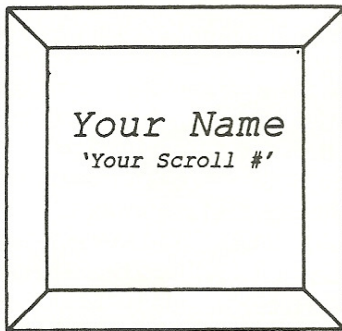


## Levels of Recognition

The following Levels of recognition have been established to honor those fraters continuing the tradition at Delta Nu.

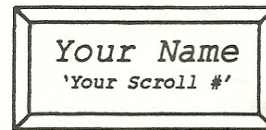
### Delta Nu Frater-\$1000 and Over

### Delta Nu Order of the Rock-\$250-\$499

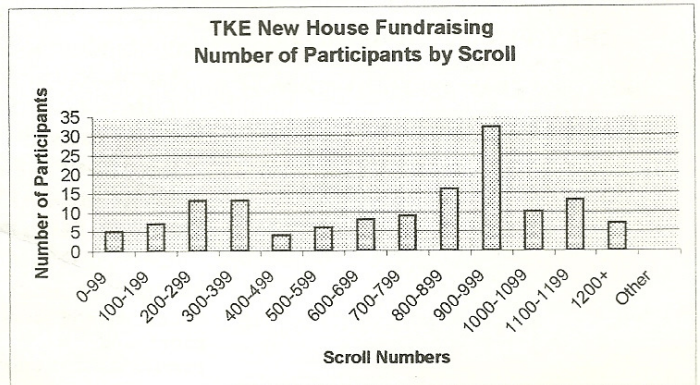
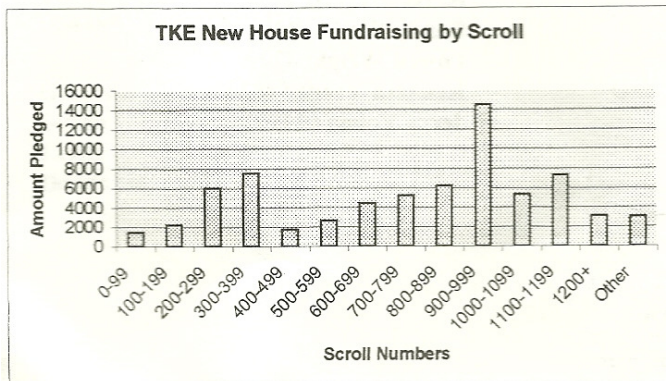
Your name will be included in a permanent plaque to be mounted in the chapter room.

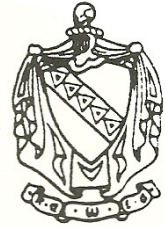

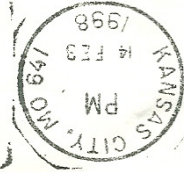
